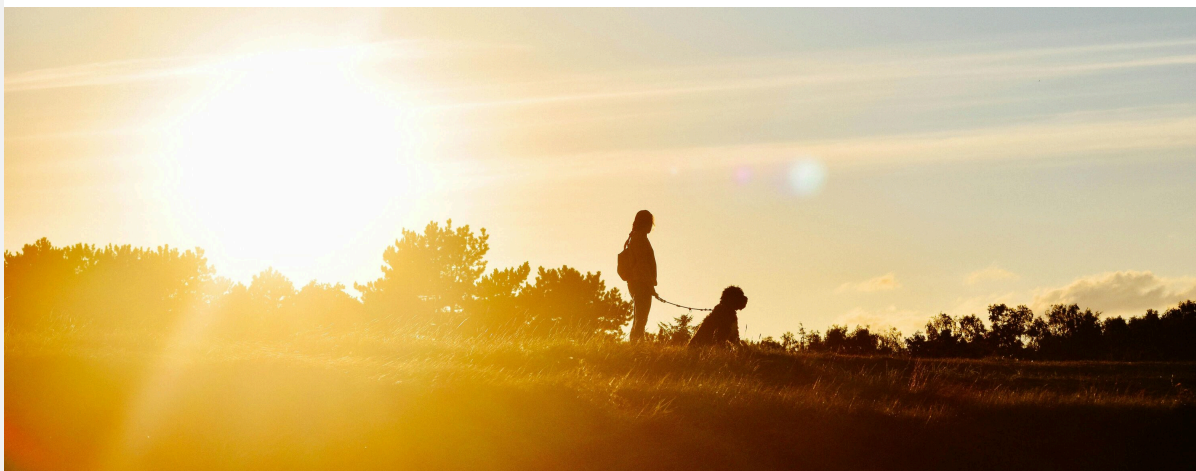

Retention of the right to transition compensation in the event of involuntary dismissal

Employers and trade unions of member companies (social partners) wish to offer employees who are involuntarily made redundant before 1 January 2027 an arrangement. This will allow them to retain their entitlement to contribution compensation when transitioning to the new pension scheme. Pensioenfonds PDN will support this.

De Nederlandsche Bank (DNB) calls for the transition decision to be adjusted

In the final quarter of 2025, we informed you of the decision taken by the Board of Pensioenfonds PDN regarding the transition to the new pension scheme. The so-called transition decision. For example, we informed you through the [interview with Piet Rennen](#). The Board had sought a middle ground between the requests made by employers and trade unions on this matter and the standard requirements that DNB imposes on pension funds. At the time, it was unclear whether DNB would consider our arguments strong enough to deviate from the standard. It has since become clear that DNB does not agree. Among other things, DNB found that the fairness of the proposed decision has not been sufficiently substantiated to permit the transition under the proposed conditions.

Why are we converting your current pension entitlements to the new pension scheme?

The unions and employers have made agreements relating the new pension scheme. Transferring existing pensions to the new pension scheme is part of these agreements. This concerns all pensions. In other words, pensions that are still accruing, as well as pensions that are in payment.

The trade unions and employers believe that converting existing pensions to the new scheme is better for members and pensioners than not converting them. In this newsletter, you'll see that discussions are currently in full swing between employers, trade unions, the Board of Pensioenfonds PDN and DNB on how to fairly implement the transition.
